



EXTRAORDINARY INSTRUCTIONS FOR RESIDENTS FOR THE PREVENTION OF THE SPREAD OF INFECTION, 1 JUNE 2020

I. Disinfection and protective masks

- Hand disinfection is mandatory before entering the dormitory and separate floors.
- When entering the dormitory, it is mandatory to use a protective mask.
- The use of a protective mask is also mandatory in common spaces.
- Each resident is obliged to provide a protective mask himself.

II. Use of lifts and staircases

- The lift can only be used by one person.
- When using the staircase, a social distance of at least 1.5 m is mandatory.

III. Accommodation in rooms, migration between floors and dormitories

- In the dormitory, residents can only be on the floor where they have a room.
- Passages between floors are prohibited.
- Visits to other dormitories are prohibited.
- Visits of residents to other rooms within the floors are prohibited.
- Visits by non-residents are prohibited.
- Overnight stays with other residents are prohibited.
- While being outside the dormitory, residents must comply with a social distance measure of at least 1.5 m.
- Residents must ventilate their living spaces several times a day.
- Relocations will not be carried out until further notice.

IV. Use of common spaces, kitchens and bathrooms

- Socializing in common spaces and passages between floors is prohibited.
- The use of indoor social spaces (music rooms, common spaces for studying, socializing rooms etc.) is prohibited.
- The use of a protective mask is mandatory in common spaces.
- At the same time, there can be a maximum of 3 people in common spaces at a distance of min. 1.5 m.
- At the same time, there can be a maximum of 3 people in the kitchen at a distance of min. 1.5 m.
- Until further notice, bed linen changes are carried out, which are announced in advance and carried out in such a way that the resident puts the dirty bedding in a bag in front of the caretaker from a distance of at least 1.5 m and closes it and puts it away in a designated place. The resident takes the clean bed linen at a designated place.
- In the dormitory's laundries, there can be only one person at a time. Hand disinfection is mandatory before and after using the laundry room. Meeting in the laundry room and mixing laundry of different users is not allowed.
- Residents are not allowed to leave their dishes in shared kitchens (it is necessary to wash the dishes regularly and take them to rooms).
- There can be only one person at a time in shared bathrooms.

V. Measures in case of signs of disease

- If you notice signs of illness (fever and other signs of acute respiratory infection), you stay in the room and avoid contact with other people.
- The patient consults the health service by telephone (selected personal physician of the patient during regular working hours, the on-duty medical service of the University Medical Centre Ljubljana (01) 522 4540 or an emergency call 112), where he/she will receive instructions on further measures.
- If you have been referred for testing by your personal or on-duty physician, you must also inform the management of the Študentski dom on the telephone number (01) 242 1000.
- In the case of a positive result, the NIJZ will begin an epidemiological investigation to seek the source of the infection and identify all the contacts, who were in contact with the infected resident. The management of ŠDL, the health inspectorate, and others are also taking part in the epidemiological investigation.

VI. Implementation

Employees of the institution and other authorized persons are in charge of supervising the implementation of these extraordinary instructions.

The measures are valid until their revocation.
