



EXTRAORDINARY INSTRUCTIONS FOR RESIDENTS FOR THE PREVENTION OF THE SPREAD OF INFECTION

I. Disinfection and protective masks

- Hand disinfection is mandatory before entering the dormitory and separate floors.
- If it is not possible to ensure a social distance of at least 1.5 m, it is recommended to use a protective mask.
- Each resident is obliged to provide a protective mask himself.

II. Use of lifts

- The lift can only be used by one person.

III. Accommodation in rooms and migrations between the dormitories

- Visits to other dormitories are prohibited.
- Visits by non-residents are prohibited.
- Overnight stays with other residents are prohibited.
- Residents must ventilate their living spaces several times a day.

IV. Use of common spaces, kitchens and bathrooms

- Social distancing in common spaces, kitchens, shared bathrooms and in other common spaces should be at least 1,5 m.
- At the same time, there can be only so many people in common areas that a minimum of 1.5 m of social distance can be maintained between them.
- If it is not possible to ensure a social distance of at least 1.5 m in common areas, it is recommended to use a protective mask.
- Common areas should be ventilated several times a day.
- Socializing in common spaces is prohibited.
- Residents are not allowed to leave their dishes in shared kitchens (it is necessary to wash the dishes regularly and take them to rooms).
- Bed linen is changed according to the schedule, when changing bed linen it is recommended that residents use a protective mask and have a social distance of 1.5 m.

V. Measures in case of signs of disease

- If you notice signs of illness (fever, cough, shortness of breath, which are typical for pneumonia), you stay in the room and avoid contact with other people.
- The patient consults the health service by telephone (selected personal physician of the patient during regular working hours, the on-duty medical service of the University Medical Centre Ljubljana (01) 522 4540 or an emergency call 112), where he/she will receive instructions on further measures.
- If you have been referred for testing by your personal or on-duty physician, you must also inform the management of the Študentski dom on the telephone number (01) 242 1000.

VI. Implementation

Employees of the institution and other authorized persons are in charge of supervising the implementation of these extraordinary instructions. The Extraordinary Instructions will enter into force on 23 June 2020 and will remain in force until revoked. On the date of entry into force of these Extraordinary Instructions, the Extraordinary Instructions from 1 June 2020 cease to be valid.
